An introduction to the Armchair Treasure Hunt (ATH): "It is not the ATH which is the difficulty; rather, it is the difficulty which is the ATH"

Adapted version of Kierkegaard quote. Danish philosopher translates as graveyard. Missing P (ATH instead of path) [it is not the path which is the difficulty; rather, it is the difficulty which is the path]

PATH is part of LONDON OUTER ORBITAL PATH as part of the main hunt. See main hunt for the remainder.

Tree is a pear tree - Christmas related with partridge in a pear tree as the first day of Christmas (homage to Pablo 2021)

Appears to use the same wix software ?fake address as location is Bakwell (missing e), Matlock area then mentions San Francisco locals. Also Interstate journeys on Our Services page. Other typos such as "area's". The name of the taxi company also seems strange with the small "j" suggesting possibly a connection to micro-speak or similar? Both San Francisco has and Matlock had a CABLE CAR TRAMWAY - could this be related to the connection between the two?

However all seems a red herring as the stock photo is used on other websites!

Photo of prison is Toronto South Detention Centre created by the Nelmar Drywall project. Again likely no relevance

Think Beet will find the above amusing!

Group is from Scooby-Doo:

NOTE: Scooby-Doo is connected to Kierkegaard as they are both GREAT DANES.

Using the Dewey decimal library classification system, these relate to: 198 = Scandinavian philosophers (relates to Kierkegaard) 791.457 = TV programmes (relates to Scooby Doo and Buffy The Vampire Slayer) 365 = Penal related (relates to prisons and prison escapes)

Gang members - Old Man Wily (prisoner), Victor, Quiet John, Ladies Man John, Funny Man, Babyface, Nicky N

The gang members align with various PSEUDONYMS used by Søren Kierkegaard, namely:-

Victor - Victor Eremita (general editor of *Either/Or*) Quiet John - Johannes de Silentio (author of *Fear and Trembling*) Ladies Man John - Johannes the Seducer (author of *The Seducer's Diary*) Funny Man - Hilarious Bookbinder (recipient, compiler and publisher of *Stages*) Babyface - Young Man (poet and author in *Repetition*) Nicky N - Nicolaus Notabene (author of *Prefaces*. N.N. was a Danish abbreviation indicating anonymity (similar to our use of Mr. X))

Old Man Wily could also be Judge Wilhelm (from work Either/Or). GERALD WILY is a PSEUDONYM for RONNIE BARKER who was a prisoner in Porridge (TV PROGRAMME about PRISONS). With Wiley changed here to Wily.

Link between Buffy the Vampire Slayer and Scooby Doo. (Note that Old Man Wily was pretending to be a Vampire). In Buffy her friends in the series become known as The Scooby Gang.

Wily tells Daphne she is the "real hero". Sarah Michelle Gellar played both Buffy and Daphne in the Scooby-Doo movies.

Dewey reference 791.457 includes the philosophy of Buffy the Vampire Slayer: Fear and Trembling in Sunnydale referencing Fear and Trembling by Kierkegaard. This mentions "is Buffy truly a Kierkegaardian knight of faith".

There was an actual Mr Wiley who was a school caretaker in the Scooby Doo episode High School Ghoul

Old Man Wily: Was 43 when caught, now 53 - both prime numbers "in his prime" (see p1 of the hunt)

Here was our own Haiku before the hunt even started:

Gromit in a prison cell (another dog cf. Scooby Doo). From *Wallace and Gromit: A Close Shave* Continues the theme of being in prison and relates to a prison escape In the full clip Gromit receives a jigsaw with the message **"Friday Night 8pm Be Ready"** and true to form the Hunt started at this time and day!

Main Hunt

Material from multiple pages

Bold letters:

These are in a thematic **Vampiro** One font (link: BUFFY THE VAMPIRE SLAYER), letters AtoZ inclusive

Bold words:

"Search brutal house martin rap" anagrams to **PABLO'S ARMCHAIR TREASURE HUNT.** It is hinted to try anagrams by the appearance of **AM A GRAN** (i.e. an anagram of **ANAGRAM**) on p1.

Five specific dates:

Using the date-of-the-month to key into the month itself spells out OUTER. Eg 2nd July -> U. Referencing part of LONDON OUTER ORBITAL PATH.

Selection of capitalized names:

BA, Face, Hannibal, Howling - the four members of The A-Team (TV programme, where this group escaped from a maximum security prison relates to PRISON ESCAPE)

Holly headers and footers:

Decoded via ternary variation using the red (2), black (1) and white (0) holly berries as follows:

Which decodes as:

SMALL DOTS:

p2 (2 1) then (2 4)
p3 (5 1)
p4 (1 5) then (1 2)
p5 (5 4)
p6 (2 1)
p7 (2 4)
p8 (5 1) then (1 5)

Using a Tap/Knock code as used by prisoners (PRISON) these dots decode as **FIVE BY FIVE**

5x5 alphabet square with C and K doing double duty is used as a standard tap/knock code grid

FIVE BY FIVE also pertains to a Playfair cipher grid

DOTS and DASHES

The dots and dashes as 'bullet points' on pages 3 (the book list), 4 (the bird list) + 8 (the lecture list) can be strung together as: --- --- .-- .-- .-- .-- .-- With suitable spacing (as above) this can be read in Morse Code as **THE WATER IS WARM**. This refers to the message in the 37th episode of TV PROGRAMME *Prison Break* entitled 'The Message'. It was used as a red herring to throw the FBI off the scent.

Individual pages:

Page 1:

The Inklings were an Oxford writers' group which included C. S. Lewis, J. R. R. Tolkien, Charles Williams, Owen Barfield, Adam Fox and Hugo Dyson (Homage to Pablo 2022). Charles Williams carried out the first large scale English translation of Søren Kierkegaard's works and Adam Fox is a link to the Fox pub close to the treasure location. Also Ronnie Barker started his career in Oxford amateur dramatics.

Highlighted text is an anagram of ANAGRAM, suggesting to anagram the other bold words on pages 2, 4 and 7 (see Bold Words section above)

"Someone in here told me that boredom is the root of all evil". Søren Kierkegaard quote reiterating the fact that Kierkegaard is in the prison somewhere.

There were three gangs (GREAT DANES, BIRDMEN (also note relevance to word 'wing'), SCOOBY GANG (or BUFFY THE VAMPIRE CHARACTERS/ANGEL CHARACTERS)

Prime letters of the last part of the 3rd paragraph spells out: LETTERS AND DOCUMENTS MONITORED IN, reasoning behind so much info in the newsletter being encoded. *Letters and Documents* was a work by Søren Kierkegaard.

Nick again relating to Søren Kierkegaard pseudonym, but also a slang term for a PRISON, Nick was also a character in Chicken Run (PRISON ESCAPE)

Long walk in the country (referencing Happy Valley) or drive to the pub (referencing The Fox pub). Hinting at the fact that the treasure is nearer The Fox Pub end of that section of the LOOP.

GW - refers to Gerald Wiley (pseudonym of Ronnie Barker) or, here, Gerald Wily, the *real* name of Old Man Wily.

Page 2:

These seem related to prison escape films

Inspection Passed -

New Rules for Tools - THE SHAWSHANK REDEMPTION (rock hammer used to escape) Search the cells (relating to the crossword and link with X-Wing Class)

Guards v Inmates Football Match - ESCAPE TO VICTORY

The "rocky" reference relates to Sylvester Stallone who was the replacement goalkeeper. Film score line matches as well as the broken arm of the goalie (also another character in Chicken Run).

Sign Our Petition -

"He hath the key, and he that shutteth no man openeth" - Revelations 3:7 reads " he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;" This starts as "and to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write" [Buffy reference (Angel)]

X-wing (sudoku reference) ? relevance. It also justifies the use of XW as prisoner numbers, where XW also refers to the CrossWord in the puzzles section. We will return to that later.

Page3:



Captain Kirk who is the guard, hence Kirk:guard, Kirkguard or Kierkegaard.

The Point of View relates to a book about Kierkegaard's pseudonyms - *The Point of View of My Work as an Author*

All the works are by pseudonyms: L'Imposteur by Molière - Jean-Baptiste Poquelin - 1664 (The actual title seems to be Tartuffe ou L'Imposteur

A Tangled Web by Nicholas Blake - Cecil Day-Lewis - 1956

A Pot of Money by Fabian Bland - Edith Nesbit - 1887 The Traveler by John Twelve Hawks - Unknown - 2005 The Long Voyage by John Christopher - Sam Youd - 1960 The Pursued by C.S. Forester - Cecil Lewis Troughton Smith - 1935 but published posthumously in 2011 You Can't Catch Me by Rosamond Smith - Joyce Carol Oates - 2005 The Quest by Saki - Hector Hugh Munro - 2020 The Lifted Veil by George Eliot - Mary Ann Evans - 1859

These can be anagrammed (links to text with "brew", "order", "new") to spell out PSEUDONYM by the initial letters of the surnames of the pseudonyms

In the penultimate paragraph, reference is made to his 'local'. This refers to The Fox pub and its beer, a bottle of which appears in a later photo.

We note the suggestion of looking him up on social media (see later)

Page4:

Pilar Fuentes is Spanish for PILLAR FOUNTAINS

Elvera Corona as Pilar Fuentes - The Sign of Zorro (1958) [prison] There is a pillar fountain on Section 5 of the LOOP close to The Fox pub and hence close to the treasure.

Eagle-eyed - birdman (see X-Wing)

Every second Tuesday - USA (Buffy is a TV programme from USA)

The reference to the twins *might* just also be referring to the Kray twins, famously imprisoned. Though we particularly note the Buffy reference (see p5 below). There are also two identical looking Birdmen in the X-wing group (p14/15), robin and eagle.

split into two in series 5, episode 3 called *The replacement* girlfriend is ANYA who is a demon Portrayed in two episodes by his twin brother, Kelly Donovan. "and the worst thing he looks just like me" suggesting twin/pseudonym

Word ANGST is attested since the 19th century in English translations of the works of Søren Kierkegaard suggests Uncle Angst is Kierkegaard. The Danish title of his work translated as *The Concept of Anxiety* is *Begrebet Angest*.

42 REDACTED words - Kierkegaard died when he was **42** This repeated word also inferring Kierkegaard's novel "*Repetition*"

Casanova - Kierkegaard's Johannes in "Diary of a seducer" is regarded as a Don Juan or Casanova

Page6:

Note the ordering as Buffy/Angel characters in every other photo, first letters (Forrest, Angelus, Izzerial, Toth, Halfrek) spell out FAITH (Buffy the Vampire Slayer character and also relates to Kierkegaard). Leap of Faith was coined by Søren Kierkegaard. Knight of Faith was coined by Søren Kierkegaard. All of Søren Kierkegaard pseudonymous writings analyze the concept of faith.

The remaining characters also appear in the XWing class p14/15 suggesting these are in fancy dress

For Self-examination ...work written by Soren Kierkegaard Dawn - Member of the Scooby Gang (Buffy the Vampire Slayer character)

It's the start of a new season and when we get our first glimpse of Dawn - suggests Season 5 of *Buffy* and being the section of The LOOP as the Treasure location (multiple characters seen in the hunt are only seen in Season 5 and others first appear then)

Janus played a key role in a Buffy episode ('Halloween', I think). He caused people to transform into costumes they wore at Halloween. He was also the God of beginnings, giving more clout that initial letters are relevant.

Below par = birdie, eagle, albatross (i.e. all birds - BIRDMEN)

Adapted quotation changing "successor" from "way" as stated by Hannibal



PHOTO is a mask of Ronnie Barker (who played Norman Stanley Fletcher in Porridge - TV programme and PRISON). Ronnie Barker famously used the pseudonym of GERALD WILEY (a parody on GERALD WILY the editor of the magazine ... see GW on p1).

"There is a lot more to the newsletter than meets the eye" directly hints to the number of encoded/enciphered information hiding within.

"Apologies for any errors ..." introduces the cleverly built-in errors that have been used to hide some of the messages. Eg in the music, crossword enumerations etc. See other sections of this document for more details.

Faengsel Ex-Inmates Light Operatic & Networking Society = FELONS Faengsel being Danish for prison (recapping from elsewhere) Get busy singing or get busy dancing is a parody on a line from Shawshank Redemption (get busy living or get busy dying)

The paragraph also relates to a Buffy the Vampire Episode produced by her - series 4, episode 2 (overall= episode 58) (*Living Conditions*) - roommate cutting toenails, playing same song again, takes Buffy's sweater etc.

Lilies of the Field and Birds of the Air - work written by Soren Kierkegaard (The Lily of the Field and the Bird of the Air (1849) a book of godly discourses)

A History of Colchester Castle - a previous prison

Note: Sirius Black played by Gary Oldman (see fancy dress and X-wing)

One of the gang disappointed as not ornithological confirms one gang is BIRDMEN

Carol Concert

Saint Leonard - Patron saint of imprisoned people

Accordion, squeeze - Concertina - link to Playfair - see wordsearch p15

Vocal chords - Note - intentional typo, linking to music sheet on p16

Ode to a ..

Hints at using a tap/knock code from dots as described earlier (also lacking cold = c)

Jeffrey Archer Prison Diary was called Hell

The Prisoner (1967), no 6 as main character (all sixes and sevens)

Potential overall feel to poem of Oscar Wilde's Ballad of Reading Gaol (Oscar Wilde was imprisoned there)

Therefore answer is YELLOW (The Loop is divided into colours, yellow being one of them) There is also the Greater **Yellow** Rattle, a rare flower, found in Happy Valley Note also that YELLOW CAR is with the text of "... on a YELLOW CARd ..." on p2, aligning with the thought that some answers are hidden within the text.


Ascot linking back to Fred's tie (Scooby) though the colour was orange

neither ... nor - Either/Or was written by Kierkegaard

First letters are PENTA, suggesting 5 (treasure location is section 5 of the LOOP) Also the first three of these spell PEN, which is an American term for prison

Taking the 5 places in England and drawing a PENTAgram, the inner region includes the location of the treasure at Happy Valley. Furthermore if an ellipse is drawn through these points and the centre point marked, leads to Coulsdon, which is the start of section 5 of the LOOP)

The remainder spell out WHAT 3 WORDS GLADIATORS.FRIDAY.APPLE and SCAR.WATERS.DENT

The locations of these are:

COULSDON SOUTH STATION and MILLENIUM CAIRN

The former being the start of Section 5 of The LOOP at Coulsdon and the latter is part of the loop heading south, suggesting to travel through these points and the treasure will be onwards from there.

The Quiz has multiple mentions of prisons, prison escapes and references to Denmark/Danes and Scooby e.g. Copenhagen where Kierkegaard was born, Ballad of Reading Gaol by Oscar Wilde (verse 6 of 109). Rosencratz and Guildenstern (see X-wing p14/15) as Danes. Sarah Waters' book Affinity features an imprisoned medium called Selina Dawes.

The introduction to the Quiz mentions "Dagger" and "sharp by name sharp by nature", signalling the Pablo tradition of including a Sean bean reference (played Sharpe in Sharpe's Sword - TV programme)



Sunnydale is location of Buffy the Vampire Slayer and a cryptic representation / pseudonym of HAPPY VALLEY (actual location of treasure). Happy Valley is also a TV show that involved prisons and criminals.

Other words relating to the overall hunt include CLINK = PRISON, LOOP upwards are 26d



The bottom row decodes as white = 0 and black = 1 in 8 bit binary converting to decimal and then via ASCII to spell LONDON (part of London Outer Orbital Path = The LOOP)

The escape from Alcatraz used a concertina to inflate the raft as hinted in carol concert on p8. The concertina was invented by Wheatstone who also invented the Playfair code based on a FIVE BY FIVE grid. The Wordsearch has no J which suggests one of the standard grids using 25 letters and no J.

First letters of the languages spell RIP JAMES a homage to a much-loved and much-missed friend James Medhurst.

The Holly code states the remaining letters in the wordsearch need decoding. There are 209 remaining letters in the wordsearch and with double letters as pairs this is likely to need adapting before carrying out the likely Playfair cipher on the remaining string. No solution has

been found for this part of the hunt, despite folding in a concertina and decoding spare letters, folding and cutting out letters to see what appears through the gaps.

Other Christmas related words are found but likely to be red herrings e.g. GOD, ROSE, TOY, COAL and BREAK (we were all looking forward to the Christmas BREAK)

Note that ORBI (penultimate column) and TAL (final column) appear in the wordsearch giving ORBITAL from London Outer Orbital Path (the LOOP).

Likewise POR and LOCK in adjacent columns looking at only the unhighlighted cells and PORLOCK was a pseudonym in Sherlock Holmes novel (FEAR OF VALLEY) who set a book cipher (not the valley link with Happy Valley).



Note the diagonal line through Oldman is signalling the Danish letter O with a line through it (Oldman's first letter) and the circle over Agger is signalling the Danish letter A with a circle over (Agger's first letter)

The first letters of the group of characters that are GREAT DANES, reorders to GREAT DANES

If the XW numbers are indexed into the crossword (XW = crossword) then the three groups can be decoded as follows:

GERALD WILY (directly from GREAT DANES in order), **TWITTER** (from Buffy characters) [note the U U means double U therefore W - this stumped us for ages!] and **HANDLE** (from the Birdmen)

GERALD WILY TWITTER HANDLE suggests to look up this Twitter account on social media. This was hinted at at p3 "keep in touch on social media", even though this was written by KIRK GUARD / KIERKEGAARD rather than GERALD WILY (the editor)

Note TWITTER is also very relevant to birds and the BIRDMEN

Page16:

The notes of the carol service are 12 Days of Christmas in F (homage to Pablo 2021) and O come all ye faithful in G

The wrong value in crotchets indexed into the word sung spells out **GREATER** pointing at the treasure being in **GREATER LONDON** (when linked with the Nomogram decoding on p11). We noted the geographical closeness of the LOOP to the Greater London boundary!

The red note on line 3 of the second page is on the syllable "**FAITH**" of faithful. Faith being a member of the Scoobygang in Buffy the Vampire Slayer and relates to Kierkegaard's philosophy.

The 12 days of christmas is also signalling the pear tree on the poster, which is the eventual place to find the treasure.

This number in base 10 is 430019, which is Faith's prison number, season 4, episode 13 "Salvage", imprisoned at the North Carolina Women's facility (Buffy the Vampire Slayer)

26 yoga poses each with a tinyurl alphanumeric string. This can be decoded using the keystring KBROS, thus:

The digits are spaces cycling 1 to 9

K BROS signalling the Kierkegaard brothers Søren and Peter

DEAR PETER I KNEW YOU WOULD REMEMBER OUR BOYHOOD CIPHER I AM SENDING YOU ENCODED INSTRUCTIONS IN CASE ANYTHING HAPPENS TO ME WHERE YOU NEED A KEYWORD USE MY CHILDHOOD NICKNAME PLUS MUMS MAIDEN NAME YOU ALSO NEED THE COMBINATION YOURS SK

SK being SØREN KIERKEGAARD

His childhood nickname was FORK and his mother's maiden name was LUND and therefore a keyword would be FORKLUND

The strings are similar to the errors from the crossword clues, however these do not decode to anything helpful. Nor does it lead to a link

The time stamps in the You Tube videos are akin to the bird code numbers, maximum here is 497 cf. 524 (unable to decode these numbers). Unable to glean anything from the yoga poses apart from B is TREE pose (VRKSASANA)

Other photos include:

- Reading Gaol (Oscar Wilde imprisoned here)
- Fox picture on beer bottle (The Fox pub is the closest to Happy Valley)
- Toad in the hole ("in the hole" refers to solitary confinement)
- Robins on cup (Birdmen) and muffins or madeleines
- Marmalade sandwich (Paddington 2, paddington was in prison and marmalade sandwiches given to inmates)
- Boiled eggs (Cool Hand Luke won a bet in prison by eating 50 hard boiled eggs)

Dolly Parton Meme are of Gerald Wiley pseudonyms:

- LinkedIn Golden Retriever (actually from Twitter Sir Geoffrey Retriever), dog being a Barker [RONNIE BARKER]
- Facebook Ferris Beueller's Day Off [BOB FERRIS]
- Instagram Goat Yoga [JACK GOETZ]
- Tinder Keith Chegwin in Naked Jungle [LARRY KEITH]

Note that Dolly Parton was an uncredited producer for Buffy the Vampire Slayer, sharing the same birthday as Buffy Summers. Dolly Parton's company created the first ever episode!

In date and order clocks in the background when converted as semaphore to letters spell out:

TINYURLDOTCOMSLASHWILYGXYZ

This leads to the link tinyurl.com/wilygxyz

This in turn leads to a flickr account with pics from notebook and 13 photos by Gerald Wily

There is a notebook code, which using the hint of French writing behind the photos can be decoded via the Vigenere cipher and the keyword from Gerald Wily's twitter **FORKLUND**

AT SOUTHERNMOST POINT LEFT INTO FIELD THEN RIGHT INTO WOOD SIXTY PACES NARROW GAP BETWEEN YOUNG TREES SIXTY PACES MORE

This gives hint that the treasure is located at the Southernmost point of section 5 of the LOOP and instructions to follow thereafter.

The 12 photos are ordered 1-12, which are a sequence of Landmarks and trees starting from the Millennium Dial (was was noted from What3Words location in the p9 Quiz), heading along the Section 5 LOOP, until pic 8 which is the point to turn left into the field, pic 9 is the point to turn right into the wood and the wood takes one past trees in pic 10 and pic 11, until the pear tree at pic 12 being identical to the poster (note the Spanish on the notebook is hidden after number 12). The treasure box is located at the bottom of the tree accessed via **combination code 2301**(see p.13 above).

Inside the treasure box is a letter written by SK (Søren Kierkegaard) aka Kirk guard from Faengsel prison, who has already stolen the treasure.





Also a Get Out Of Jail Free card!

So in order to find out where he might be heading we looked for Søren Kierkegaard's Twitter handle @kirkguard https://twitter.com/kirkguard

States he was born May 5 (and Søren Kierkegaard was born 05/05/1813 in Copenhagen)

The wolf that is put to tending sheep relating to wolf in sheep's clothing suggesting mask/pseudonym (John 10:12) and is also part of a Kierkegaard quote

Another Dolly Parton meme, this time Kierkegaard pseudonyms:

Dean and Dawson is the code name used by forgers to help escape from Stalag Luft III detailed in "The Great Escape"

Drawing of butterfly suggests Papillon and therefore the novel of the same name (made into a film), multiple prison escapes.

The numbers are international dialling codes for countries, which are identical to the order visited in Papillon (papillon being the pseudonym of Charrière)

Note the link here with Devil's Island and Devil Den, which is along the route in Section 5 of the LOOP. one has to pass through Devil Den as per the sequence of trees. Devil continues the demon theme of Buffy the Vampire Slayer.

Behind the Twitter/X photos were French and Spanish phrases. The posts are also a combination and sometimes a portmanteau of both. He is travelling to places where one or the other is required (on top of English, which he has already demonstrated he knows already) - see Language column in table above.

These translate to:

I am learning Spanish and French at the same time and it is very difficult and I mix the two languages in my head. Thus there are lots of errors – I feel it.

It is very cold today. I want to live in a country that is more warm.

Where is my notebook - this is a reference to the book that he lost in the prison which contained the codes

For those that want to learn a new language - my French teacher is called Mr LeGros [note: LeGros = el Gordo in Spanish which is the name of the Spanish lottery]

My Spanish teacher is Mr Ruiz. He is a very interesting man. He was a doctor but now works as a caretaker [note: The Doctor was undercover as a caretaker called John Smith]

How do you say "Later losers" in French?

How can one overcome fear of flying? I avoid it if it is possible, but I will do a big trip and apart from the first stage, I have to fly.

And I can't go in a ship as I am seasick on the Thames Clipper.

My suitcases are packed

.....

How to catch the thief:

His first stop is France, but he will not travel from England to France via ferry as he is seasick and he will not fly on this occasion. Therefore that leaves road or rail.

Final photo is a calendar of January (BS = Buffy Summers, date of birth 19th January 1981 and RO = Regine Olsen, date of birth 23rd January 1822 ... she was engaged to Søren Kierkegaard). The departure date and time is 15th January at 06:01. There is an actual Eurostar leaving St Pancras heading to Paris at this time and date.
